The installed capacity of the CHP Energy Centre.

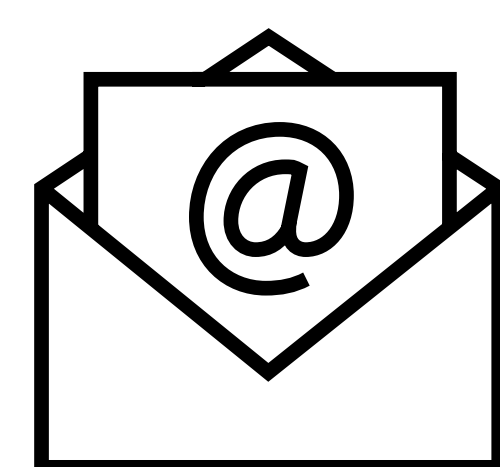
### Autumn 2019

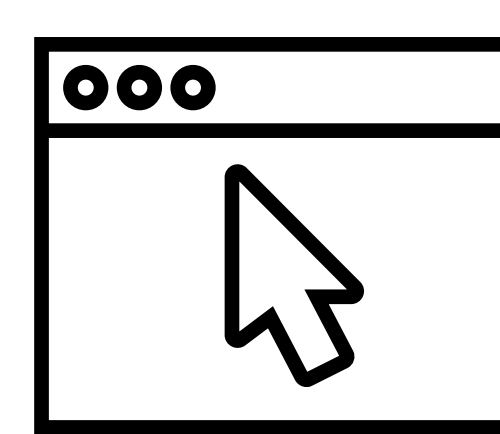
